

## THE PERCEPTION OF GENDER AND WOMEN IN TURKEY 2018

## General Framework

The study was conducted with 1205 people 18 years old and older representing the urban population of Turkey. According to the 2017 ADNK (Address-based population registration) data, the urban population constitutes $92 \%$ of the total population in Turkey. Sample choice was made by random sample selection based on cluster sampling. The fieldwork of the research was carried out between January and February 2018 and it was conducted by Frekans Araștırma (Frekans Research).

The regular contribution of paternal care is generally low. There is increase in contributions like spending time outside with kids, playing, taking care of kids' school problems, helping with their studies and regular care. Even though regular care does not exceed $48 \%, 20$ percent of them reported that they don't play with their children at all.

While the regular contribution of fathers in child care is low, the majority does not desire to contribute more: $37 \%$ say "no".

- Yes, I would like to contribute much more
- Yes, I would like to contribute a little more
- No, I contribute enough

While the regular contribution of fathers in child care is low, the number of mothers who wish their spouse to be more involved is not high as well: 29\% say "no" .

$74 \%$ agreed that children, regardless their gender, should not be allowed to get married under any circumstances, while the remaining $25 \%$ approves that children should be allowed to get married with their own consent, a court decision or with the consent of their parents only.

## The Official Marriage Authority of İmam/mufti

Do you approve that the Imam/muftis has the official marriage authority?

64\% of women don't approve the authority of Imam/Mufti for official marriage, while the number of men who are against decrease to $52 \%$.
